Flint Journal Endorses Senator Stabenow Praises Stabenow's Understanding of, Advocacy for Michigan

Lansing—Senator Debbie Stabenow today received the endorsement of the Flint Journal for her re-election to the United States Senate. This is the fourth newspaper to endorse a candidate for the general election, all of which have endorsed Senator Stabenow.

In their endorsement, the Flint Journal stated that there is “no doubt” whose side Senator Stabenow is on, and that “Stabenow fights for Michigan and its work-a-day residents.”

The Flint Journal described Stabenow as a “tireless advocate for fairer trade to help U.S. employers, cheaper prescription drugs and better educational opportunities for young people who must compete for jobs globally.”

Addressing the number one issue on the mind of Michigan, jobs, the Flint Journal drew a sharp distinction between Stabenow and her opponent, Mike Bouchard. The editorial board praised Stabenow's work on a tax cut for manufacturers who create jobs in America and her bipartisan efforts to create a U.S. Trade Prosecutor to enforce trade laws. Turning to Mr. Bouchard, they stated, “But his economic plan generally seems to be standard GOP philosophy, not something aimed at the problems facing Michigan during this economic restructuring.”

The Flint Journal pointed to health care as another issue on which Senator Stabenow had delivered results, specifically highlighting her recent successful effort to allow U.S. citizens to legally bring cheaper prescription drugs purchased in Canada back across the border.

In closing, the editorial board stated that Stabenow “...understands issues important to Michigan and will work for us every day. Such advocacy should be retained.”

“I am very proud to have the endorsement of the Flint Journal, and the support of people across Michigan,” said Stabenow. “There is a clear choice in this election and the people of Michigan know what is at stake. I am fighting and delivering results for Michigan workers and their families everyday.”
