Saginaw News Endorses Stabenow

Lansing—The Saginaw News today endorsed Senator Debbie Stabenow for re-election to the United States Senate. This is the ninth newspaper publication to endorse Senator Stabenow in the general election, joining the Detroit Free Press, Lansing State Journal, Flint Journal, Bay City Times, Traverse City Record-Eagle, the Observer & Eccentric, the Michigan Daily, and the Greenville Daily News.

The Saginaw News stated Senator Stabenow “has delivered for mid-Michigan and Saginaw since she was elected.” The Saginaw News highlighted the Senator’s concrete results, specifically citing her work to improve Saginaw’s highways and roads as well as her support of the Saginaw Art Museum. The paper stated that “the region welcomes her recognition of the challenges and her attention to urban and rural needs. She has remained plugged into Saginaw and its needs through the Saginaw County Chamber of Commerce and Saginaw Future Inc.”

In making their endorsement, the Saginaw News pointed to Stabenow’s accomplishments at the state and national level. “She also opposed the Central American Free Trade Agreement, something that pleased the region’s sugar beet industry, and voted for tax cuts that are incentives to job creation in this country,” stated the Saginaw News. “She’s also delivered for Michigan by standing up for improved national health care -- she calls health care a ‘right not a privilege’ -- to allow the federal government to negotiate lower drug prices for Medicare recipients, and for pension protection.”

Discussing Stabenow’s opponent, Mike Bouchard, the Saginaw News noted that Bouchard supports the Republican politics and strategies in Washington that Americans are rejecting.

“His jobs plan, on the other hand, is standard Republican fare,” stated the Saginaw News. “Those are all strategies the Republicans in control in Washington have successfully pushed under the Bush administration. Unfortunately for Bouchard, Americans are unhappy with the results.”

“I am very proud to have the endorsement of the Saginaw News, and the support of people across Michigan,” said Stabenow. “There is a clear choice in this election and the people of Michigan know what is at stake. I am fighting and delivering results for Michigan workers and their families every day.”
