Stabenow, State Leaders, Bring Fight for Pensions to Saginaw

Saginaw – U.S. Senator Debbie Stabenow, State Representative and State Senate Candidate Carl Williams, and Democratic Candidate for Attorney General Amos Williams today joined members of the local UAW in Saginaw to discuss the importance of pension protection for Michigan families who count on their pension for retirement.

“In Michigan, million of workers and retirees are counting on their pension for retirement security,” said Stabenow. “A lifetime of work and payments into a pension system must be honored. Promises made must be promises kept.”

"I spent 24 years at Delphi and I've received the letters saying our pensions are at risk," said Rep. Carl Williams. "Republicans in the state legislature just don't get it, but I believe that if you've worked hard your whole life and played by the rules, you deserve the pension you've earned. I have a plan to help stop outsourcing, provide emergency assistance to local workers, and safeguard our pensions."

“As Attorney General I want to be part of a team of federal legislators like Debbie Stabenow and state legislators like Carl Williams that can pass good laws that will safeguard pensions and protect seniors,” said Amos Williams. “I will defend those laws and protect the citizens of Michigan.”

Stabenow successfully worked to strengthen provisions in the pension bill for Michigan manufacturers, including the auto industry. The pension reform legislation passed the U.S. Senate in August.
